Mandatory Vaccinations for MPL Employees and Volunteers

Milton Public Library (MPL) has adopted a mandatory vaccine policy for all employees and volunteers, which came into effect on 15th September 2021.

All MPL employees and volunteers, including members of the MPL Board, are required to have received a full series of any federally approved COVID-19 vaccine, or combination, thereof, and to provide the corresponding documentation issued by the Ontario Ministry of Health, or equivalent, by 30th October 2021.

The health and safety of employees, volunteers and patrons of MPL is the number one priority. This policy demonstrates a commitment to taking every reasonable precaution in the circumstances for the protection of the health and safety of everyone, from COVID-19.

In upholding this policy, MPL will comply with all human rights requirements and accommodate employees as necessary.
