

Milton Public Library to Host Best-selling Children's Author, Gordon Korman on January 30th, 2025

Milton, ON – Milton Public Library is pleased to host renowned children's author **Gordon Korman** for a special event, "**Writing Adventures with Gordon Korman**" on January 30th, 2025 at the FirstOntario Arts Centre Milton. With over 90 books to his name, including beloved titles such as *Swindle*, *Restart*, and *Schooled*, Korman has captivated young readers for more than four decades. This exciting event is designed to inspire and engage students, offering them a rare chance to connect with one of the most influential voices in children's literature today.

Students will have the opportunity to hear firsthand from Korman about his journey from writing his first book at the age of 14 to becoming a best-selling author. He will share insights into his writing process, offer advice to aspiring young writers, and explore the themes and inspirations behind his most popular stories.

The event will feature two presentations tailored to different grade levels. The first session, designed for grades 2-4, will begin at 10:30 AM, followed by a second session for grades 5-8 at 12:30 PM. Korman's books have been a staple in classrooms and libraries for years, and this event will offer students a personal connection to an author whose stories have shaped generations of young readers.
